SPEAKER: James Ricker

James comes to us from Sanford, ME where he was born and raised. Having graduated from Sanford High School, he was chosen out of many to take a 4-year apprenticeship tool and die program. He became the youngest tool and die maker lead man at Saco Defense at age 22. Also in his 20's he had a manufacturer's rep business marketing custom automation equipment producing the first video advertisement in New England.
